Committee members

Grants Committee: Evaluates grants proposals and makes site visits to make informed funding recommendations to the membership

- Read, discuss, and vote on all proposals
- Research issues related to the grant proposals in order to make informed decisions
- Serve as members of site visit teams to learn more about applicants' projects

Membership & Communications Committee: Recruits and retains members of the giving circle

Committee members

- Coordinate and host events such as Celebrate WFW and the Spring Gathering
- Contact new members to welcome them and answer questions
- Ensure members have the information they need to speak confidently about the work of the giving circle and encourage women to join
